Call to Order & Introduction: Colleen Trybula called the meeting at 6:01pm

Approval of Minutes from last meeting in February Anne motions to approve the February minutes, Colleen seconds

Reports:

- * President: Colleen Trybula - Thank you's and updates Thank you to Angie of the website update, thank you to Tracy for the spirit wear sale, thank you to Ashlie and Angie for working the Mardi Gras Cultural Day, it went great. Students from Badger went well. It's suggested we consider a food alternative next year due to food restrictions.
- * Vice President: Tracy Pesche - Silent Auction Update Planning is going well and the ticket price has been set at \$35pp. Invitations are going to print and will be sent home.
- * Treasurer: Anne Doebler - Budget update and Ski Program Tonya came to explain how the Ski Program is billed: Student Council covers \$2 and WPTG \$8. There were 298 lift tickets purchased so $298 \times 8 = \$2,384$. WPTG had budgeted \$4,500 and a check was written for the remaining \$2,116. The school will issue a check back in that amount (\$2,116) as it was not needed this year. Next year we might consider covering the entire lift ticket (\$10). Current Surplus is \$20,283.55 Current Account Balance is \$35,268.71
- * Secretary: Ashlie Moelter - not present

Old Business

- * Picture Lady - taking a pass right now Waiting for a zip drive to see an example of her lesson

- * Spirit Wear- closes March 9th 37 items were ordered, WPTG ordered an additional 16 YS shirts as a possible gift for incoming 4K students next school year.
- * Dine to Donate at Buona on March 6th Went well and Colleen will report at a later date how much was raised.
- * Family Fun Fair - maybe another time
- * Approved Grants: None for February

New Business (Requiring Motion/Vote)

- * Swings Proposal \$4,500 (8th Grade) + \$9,000 (WPTG)=\$13,500 set aside for swing project right now, still short \$11,500 to reach the \$25,000 project cost. Group decides to wait and consider all options before moving forward.
- * Puppies Tracy proposed a Pet a Puppy event with Golden Retriever puppies. Most likely looking at the 2nd week of April, dependent upon puppies. Would be a nice pick me up in the afternoon after Forward Exams (possibly 4/7 or 14). Anne suggested tying it in with a service project and students could bring in donations for the Animal Shelter?
- * Teacher Appreciation Week May 5-9. Colleen will check with Lynn so we don't conflict with anything she has planned. Possible ideas: Tuesday-Bagels from Panera for breakfast?, Wednesday- Lunch?, \$20 Kwiktrip Gift Cards? (Budgeted \$1,200)
- * Approve Grants Stephanie Freitag requested \$200 for food from Los Agaves for Cinco de Mayo for Middle Schoolers. Colleen approved, Tracy second.
